# Classroom Policies

## Food and Drinks

Students may bring a light, healthy, snack and water. Snacks are not for sharing. The student will be expected to clean up after themselves.

## Electronic Devices Policy

Phones should never be out, unless the teacher has approved the use. Phones should remain turned off and in the student's backpack or given to the teacher to keep until the end of the day. If the student is caught with their phone, it will be sent to the office for parent retrieval.

## Fun Friday

**Students with 4 or more marks for the week or serve time in ISS during the week will not participate in Fun Friday activity.**

## BIRTHDAYS

Students may bring store bought items such as cupcakes, or other wrapped treats.

## Absentee Policy

It is the student's responsibility to check with the teacher to make up any assignments missed due to absences.

A student is given 1 extra day to make-up work per day missed.

If bellwork or station work was missed, it is to be completed as homework.

## Late or Incomplete Work Policy

The expectation is that **all assignments** be complete to a level of proficiency (70% or higher) and turned in on time. The teacher may ask students who do not complete work to proficiency to redo the assignment.

**Late work** will lose 5 points for everyday it is late. Late work will only be accepted for 5 days after the due date. **After the 5th day**, no late work will be accepted. This is to create responsibility and fairness in the classroom.
