September is Hydrocephalus Awareness Month

Per Brazos ISD Policy, this fact sheet is being distributed for your information.

Hydrocephalus is the abnormal buildup of cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) in the cavities, or ventricles, in the brain.

CSF has three important functions

- To keep the brain tissue buoyant, acting as a cushion or "shock absorber"
- To act as the vehicle for delivering nutrients to the brain and removing waste
- To flow between the cranium and spine and compensate for changes in the amount of blood within the brain

When there is an imbalance between the amount of CSF produced and the rate at which it is absorbed, the pressure of excessive CSF can damage brain tissues and cause a large spectrum of impairments in the brain. Hydrocephalus can be present at birth (congenital) or acquired during a person's life due to hemorrhage, meningitis, head trauma, tumors or cysts.

Symptoms

Among school-aged children, signs and symptoms may include: abnormal enlargement of a child's head; headache; nausea or vomiting; fever; loss of previously acquired skills, such as walking or talking; blurred or double vision; unstable balance; irritability; change in personality; decline in school performance; seizures and difficulty remaining awake or waking up.

Treatment

The most common treatment for hydrocephalus is the surgical placement of a tube, or shunt, into the person's body. It consists of a long, flexible tube with a valve that keeps fluid from the brain flowing in the right direction and at the proper rate. One end of the tubing is usually placed in one of the brain's ventricles. The tubing is then tunneled under the skin to another part of the body where the excess CSF can be more easily absorbed as in the abdomen or a chamber in the heart. People who have hydrocephalus usually need a shunt system for the rest of their lives, and regular monitoring is required.

Septiembre es Mes de Conciencia Hidrocefalia

Por política de Brazos ISD, esta hoja informativa se distribuye para su información.

La hidrocefalia es la acumulación anormal de líquido cefalorraquídeo (CSF) en las cavidades o ventrículos del cerebro. CSF tiene tres funciones importantes

- mantener boyante, el tejido cerebral que actúa como un amortiguador
- actuar como el vehículo para la entrega de nutrientes al cerebro y eliminación de residuos
- para fluir entre el cráneo y la columna vertebral y compensar los cambios en la cantidad de sangre dentro del cerebro cuando hay un desequilibrio entre la cantidad de I-CR producido y la tasa a la que es absorbida, la presión del CSF excesivo puede dañar los tejidos del cerebro y causar un amplio espectro de problemas en el cerebro. La hidrocefalia puede estar presente al nacer (congénito) o adquirido durante la vida de una persona debido a la hemorragia, meningitis, trauma, tumores o quistes.

Síntomas

En niños de edad de escolar entre, signos y síntomas pueden incluir: agrandamiento anormal de la cabeza de un niño; dolor de cabeza; náusea o vómito; fiebre; pérdida de habilidades previamente adquiridas, tales como caminar o hablar; visión borrosa o doble; equilibrio inestable; irritabilidad; cambio en la personalidad; disminución en el rendimiento escolar; convulsiones y dificultad para permanecer despierto o despertarse.

Tratamiento

El tratamiento más común para la hidrocefalia es la colocación quirúrgica de un tubo, o derivación, en el cuerpo de la persona. Consiste en un tubo largo y flexible con una válvula que mantiene el líquido en el cerebro que fluye en la dirección correcta y a la velocidad adecuada. Uno de los extremos de la tubería se coloca generalmente en uno de los ventrículos del cerebro. El tubo entonces es tunetizado bajo la piel a otra parte del cuerpo donde el exceso CSF puede ser más fácilmente absorbido como en el abdomen o una cámara en el corazón. Las personas que tienen hidrocefalia generalmente necesitan un sistema de derivación para el resto de sus vidas, y monitoreo regular es necesario.

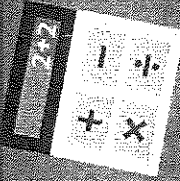

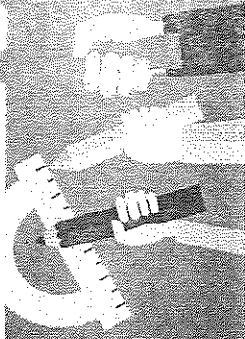
