2018 Brazos Junior/Senior Prom Dress Code Rules and Regulations

DRESS CODE:

Parents are expected to monitor and approve clothing according to the following guidelines. Failure to adhere to the guidelines will result in being denied entry to the prom and forfeiture of prom ticket. **If you are concerned your prom dress might not meet guidelines, take a picture of yourself in the dress and see Mr. Cormier to have the dress approved.** If the dress does not meet guidelines and you wait until prom night, you will be denied entrance and will forfeit your ticket.

GIRLS

- Dress is formal as Junior/Senior Prom is a formal occasion
- Knee length, tea length or long dresses are permitted. Short skirts/dresses must be not shorter than mid-thigh.
- Dresses must have necklines that ensure appropriate coverage of the bust area.
- Dresses must have backlines that sufficiently cover appropriate areas.
- Dresses that show more than **2 inches** of bare stomach and/or sides of the torso OR are see through need to have administration approval.
- Dresses with low-cut or plunging necklines that expose too much are not allowed. A dress that may be acceptable on one person may expose too much on another one, depending on body shape and size.
- Dresses with side, front, or back slits that extend above mid-thigh are not permitted.
- Proper under garments must be worn.

BOYS

- Tuxedos or suits with a dress shirt, pants and tie are allowed.
- No hats (casual or formal) or canes will be allowed inside the Prom for security purposes.

GENERAL

- Proper and formal grooming is expected. No unusual hairstyles or hair color will be allowed.
- Footwear should be formal. No athletic shoes, work boots, flip-flops etc.
- Students are encouraged to limit the items they bring to Prom, as the school and venue are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Dress code guidelines apply to accessories and jewelry. No nose, facial, tongue jewelry or grills are allowed.

REGULATIONS:

- Junior and Senior Fees must be paid in full in order to attend the Prom. Fees must be paid in full before purchasing a ticket - no exceptions.
- All Prom attendees must have a ticket for themselves and their guest. Guest who are not Brazos students will be asked to show photo ID (school ID or driver's license) at event.
- Guests who are not Brazos students must fill out the Brazos Student Guest Form prior to purchasing ticket. Mr. Cormier will approve all guest forms.
- The photo booth will be at Prom. Students can take prom photos at this booth and take their souvenir photo home with them that night.
- The Prom will begin at 8:00 p.m. There will be no admittance to Prom after 10:00 p.m. Once you exit the Prom, you will not be allowed to re-enter. The Prom will end promptly at 12:00 a.m.
- All Prom attendees should conduct themselves in an orderly manner. All school rules apply for Brazos students and guests. Anyone not conducting him/herself in an orderly and appropriate manner will be asked to leave the Prom and their parent will be notified immediately. Appropriate discipline procedures will follow in accordance with the student handbook. Violations will result in consequences deemed appropriate by school officials (e.g., suspensions, expulsions, notification of law enforcement, etc. [reminder: event held in Fort Bend County])
- Smoking, alcohol or drug use is not permitted by anyone attending Prom. Anyone suspected to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be reported to campus administration and the police officers on duty. (Reminder: event is held in Fort Bend County)
- Guests over the age of 20 are not allowed to attend.
- Middle school/Jr. High students are not allowed to attend as a guest.
- Guests must be in good standing at their school and have no record of serious misconduct.
- Students in an alternative (DAEP/JJAEP) school setting are not allowed to attend.
- If students need to go to their vehicle for any reason they must be escorted by an administrator. If you leave the prom without supervision, you will not be allowed to re-enter.
