Families.

This is Tracy Boss, principal at Brazos Elementary School, with an important message. We were notified that, over the weekend, a first grader had tested positive for COVID-19. The student was last on the elementary school campus on Friday, 11/06/2020. Common areas have been cleaned and disinfected, as outlined in our Brazos return to school plan.

The individual will self-isolate at home until the following three are met:

- The individual has not had a fever (temperature greater than 100.0 degrees) for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.
- Symptoms have improved (for example, cough and shortness of breath).
- At least 10 days have passed since the first symptoms appeared.

Brazos ISD along with the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) will lead the contact investigation. Individuals identified as close contacts have been notified by BISD and will self-quarantine for 14 days per CDC recommendations. If you have not already been notified with a phone call from BISD, then your child was not in close contact with the positive individual.

• Close contact is determined as anyone who is within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes.
