Families,

This is Eric Cormier, principal at Brazos High School, with an important message. Yesterday evening, 10/27/20, BHS was notified that a student and staff member have tested positive for COVID-19. The student and staff member were last on the High School campus on Tuesday, October 27th only in the morning. Common areas have been cleaned and disinfected, as outlined in our Brazos return to school plan.

The individuals will self-isolate at home until the following three are met:

- The individual has not had a fever (temperature greater than 100.0 degrees) for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.
- Symptoms have improved (for example, cough and shortness of breath).
- At least 10 days have passed since the first symptoms appeared.

Brazos ISD along with the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) will lead the contact investigation. Individuals identified as close contacts have been notified by BISD and will self-quarantine for 14 days per CDC recommendations. If you have not already been notified with a phone call from BISD, then your child was not in close contact with the positive student or staff member.

 Close contact is determined as anyone who is within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes.
