School Year 2020-2021 Prices will increase

Each year school food authorities participating in the National School Lunch Program are required to ensure funds are provided to the nonprofit school food service account for meals served to students not eligible for free and reduced meals. There are two ways to meet this requirement either through the prices charged for paid meals or through other non-Federal funds to the non-profit school service account.

For SY 2019-2020 SFA's on the weighted average, charged less than \$3.09 for paid lunches are required to adjust their weighted average lunch price or add non-Federal funds to the non-profit school food service account. The recommend weighted lunch average for SY 2020-2021 is \$3.05. This number is rounded down to the nearest \$.05 cents.

I have used the Paid Lunch Equity Tool for SY 2020-2021 provided by the USDA to calculate our weighted average price, which does not comply with the requirements set forth. I am proposing all lunch prices and adult and visitors breakfast increase by the maximum of \$.10 at all campus levels so that we are in compliance.
