

Brazos High School academic competitions have gotten off to a strong start in 2017! We have multiple student groups advancing to the state competition in their field.

TRACTOR TECH

The Brazos FFA Tractor Tech team of Joe Buford, Kyle Neiman, and Colten Mayo placed 2nd in the Area III Tractor Tech competition, one point behind the first place team. What is Tractor Tech you ask? Tractor Tech is three part competition. Team members appraise components and parts of tractors and agricultural implements and make recommendations for services needed and not needed, complete a written exam, and finally the team of three members, working as a group, locates and corrects five deliberately placed malfunctions in a diesel fueled tractor and safely navigates the repaired tractor through a driving course within the 25 minute time limit. CX DEBATE

For the first time in ten years, Brazos High School is sending a CX Debate team to the State Debate competition. The Brazos CX debate team of lan Martin and Kyle Neiman placed second at the district debate meet. CX, or Cross Examination Debate is one of three types of debate. The other two are Lincoln-Douglas Debate and Congressional



Debate. CX is a debate over policy. Instead of a one -on-one duel like you saw during the Presidential debates, CX is performed between teams of two, each taking turns at the stand, asking questions, reading evidence, and using forensic skill to argue for policy change by the United States federal government. This year's topic concerned foreign policy; The United States federal government should substantially increase its economic and/or diplomatic engagement with the People's Republic of China.

CX debate consists of 8 minute planning and preparation periods and 3 minute cross examination periods during which positives and negatives are attacked or defended. The debate concludes with 5 minute periods of weighing the issues. A forensic judge evaluates the teams' arguments to determine whether the affirmative proves that the adoption of the resolution would be in the best interests of the United States. TACS ACADEMIC CHALLENGE

The Texas Association of Community Schools holds an annual academic challenge in which teams of three students of varying academic ability respond to questions based on the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for English, mathematics, science, and social studies. This was the first time Brazos High School sent a team to the TACS Academic Challenge. Our team of three, lan Martin, Zach Walters, and Dekorreon Hodges placed third at the Regional meet and qualified for state.
