Our curriculum will include:

- Listening and Speaking Skills

7th grade students will take the STAAR writing test on April 6, 2021. Testing techniques will be incorporated into instruction throughout the year prior to the test.

My grading policy is as follows:

- Weekly grades will be given in grammar, revision, editing, spelling, and various writing activities.
- Exam and major writing projects may be counted twice.
- Students will be given an opportunity for improvement on exam grades in the form of retesting, correction, or an alternate assignment at the discretion of the teacher and following BMS grading guidelines listed in the student handbook.

- Any opportunities for corrections to projects or daily work to improve a grade will be given at the teacher's discretion and will vary.
- Late assignments will follow BMS grading policies.

When a student is absent:

- It is the student's responsibility to make up any work missed while absent.
- Assignment due dates will follow the BMS grading policies.

Supplies needed:

- One smaller three-ring binder (no large ones please!)
- One package of wide-ruled paper
- Pens, pencils, highlighters, glue sticks, scissors, and erasers should be brought to class every day
