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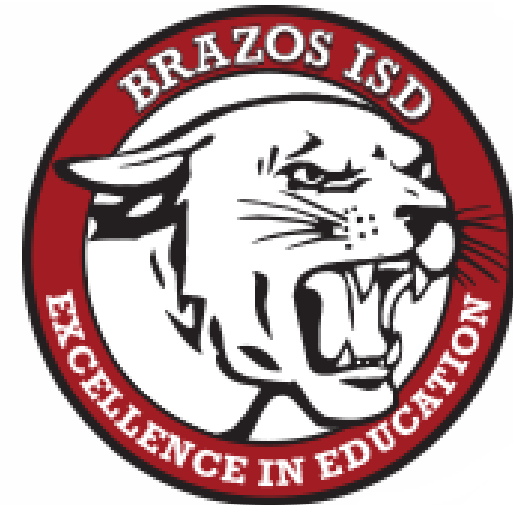

TIMELINE OF EVENTS

February:

- Turn in your course selection indicating whether or not you intend to take dual credit courses

May:

- Apply to WCJC Dual Credit through [ApplyTexas.org](https://www.applytexas.org). See QR on the back of this pamphlet.
- Fill out a Dual Credit/Early Admission Form.
- Take the TSIA to become dual credit eligible, if you have never done so before. Your counselor will schedule you a time to test.
- Your counselor sends a list of student rosters to WCJC, then WCJC will register you for classes.
- Your school registrar sends your transcript at the end of the semester.

August:

- Check your schedule to make sure you are enrolled in the correct dual credit courses through Brazos HS.
- Receive information about logging into Canvas for WCJC classes
- Check Canvas to ensure you are enrolled in the correct courses through WCJC.
- Contact your counselor if there are any issues.
- Pay your fees and course costs
 - *Brazos ISD covers the cost of one class per semester per student (pending any financial emergencies)*

September:

- The end of the 1st 6 weeks will be the deadline to switch out of dual credit into regular high school courses. Be aware of deadlines for dropping courses at WCJC.
