

BRAZOS ISD REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES
April 22, 2026 (UNOFFICIAL)

1. Establish a quorum – Call to Order: The Brazos ISD Board of Trustees held a Regular Meeting on Wednesday, April 22, 2026 in the Brazos ISD Board Room. President Myles Marek called the meeting to order at 7:02PM and declared a quorum. Members present were Matt Demny, Myles Marek, Florian Sliva, Jenny Stroud, Brian Demny, Tammy McCain and Justin Richardson.

1.1 Invocation: The invocation was led by Matt Demny.
