

BRAZOS ISD SPECIAL BOARD MEETING MINUTES
June 22, 2026 (UNOFFICIAL)

1. Establish a quorum – Call to Order: The Brazos ISD Board of Trustees held a Special Meeting on Wednesday, June 22, 2026 in the Brazos ISD Board Room. President, Myles Marek, called the meeting to order at 6:00PM, and declared a quorum. Members present were Matt Demny, Myles Marek, Tammy McCain, Florian Sliva, Justin Richardson, Brian Demny and Jenny Stroud.

2. Invocation and Pledges of Allegiance: The invocation and Pledge of Allegiance/Texas Pledge was led by Tammy McCain.

3. Public Comment: No one signed up to speak as allowed by policy BED public participation.

4. Presentation: Bond 2025 Progress Update

4.1 Proposition A Project Status: Superintendent Dave Plymale provided an update on the progress of Proposition A projects, including classroom renovations and parking lot improvements at the high school, classroom additions and cafeteria expansion at the elementary school and classroom additions at the middle school.

4.2 Proposition B Project Status: Superintendent Dave Plymale informed attendees bids received for Proposition B projects have exceeded initial estimates. He explained the factors contributing to higher costs and emphasized the importance of the Board prioritizing and determining which voter-approved projects can be completed within the available bond funds.

4.3 Review of Current Project Costs and Budget

Considerations: Assistant Superintendent Tiffani Shirley reviewed the estimated bids associated with the original Proposition B projects and discussed budget considerations.

4.4 Review of Available Options for Proposition B

Projects: Superintendent Dave Plymale presented two feasible options for completed Proposition B projects and informed attendees they would have the opportunity to provide community input by voting on their preferred option through a secret ballot.

5. Town Hall Discussion and Community Input Regarding Proposition B: The Board of Trustees will receive community feedback regarding Proposition B projects and priorities. Community members will be invited to ask questions, provide

comments, and share input regarding potential next steps for the Proposition B bond projects. Trustees may listen, ask clarifying questions, and receive information from administration; however, no Board action will be taken during this discussion item: Board President, Myles Marek, opened the discussion to the public for feedback on Proposition B projects.

6. Closing Remarks – Board President: President Myles Marek thanking everyone for attending and for providing their feedback regarding Proposition B projects.

7. Adjourn: After having completed all agenda items, Tammy McCain moved with a second by Jenny Stroud to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously. President, Myles Marek, adjourned the meeting at 6:53PM, June 22, 2026.
