

SHAC Meeting Minutes

February 25, 2026

1. Welcome

Meeting was called to order by Bailey Demny at 4:03pm. Five members were in attendance with Bailey Demny, Sarah Henderson and Roxanna Garcia in person. Rachel Daniel and Clay Hudgins joined virtually.

2. Update and Review of Old Business

Bailey Demny reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. The SHAC was informed that the new AED for the High School is still on backorder, hopefully coming in by the end of this school year. The Kids and Cops program is going well with good reviews from the officer and the students. Airway clearance devices are available in the cafeteria at each campus.

3. Discussed adding unassigned epinephrine to the Medical Standing Orders

- a. Bailey Demny explained the policy about adding epinephrine to the orders and what was required. The school provider who signs the orders agreed that Neffy, a nasal spray epinephrine, would be appropriate for our district and said that he wouldn't have a problem signing off on it. SHAC reviewed the requirements for the Administration Report and agreed that it had all the requirements necessary to follow state and school policies. The nasal sprays will be kept in the clinics (with the Narcan) and with the athletic trainer. These locations will need to be added to the AED map for each campus. A notice will have to be sent out to parents electronically or on paper that our district will have this available before implementation, as well as each year. The maintenance, use and disposal will follow the same guidelines as the Narcan policy.

4. Topics for discussion for the next meeting

- a. Bailey Demny informed the SHAC that we will be reviewing the Triennial Assessment and Wellness Policy, as well as possibly reviewing a rough draft of a Cardiac Emergency Response Plan (CERP) Protocol that will be required for the district starting in 2027-2028. No other topics were voiced to add to the April agenda.
