

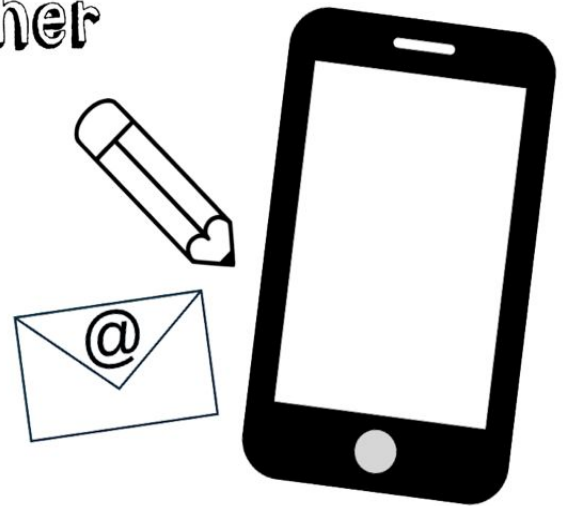

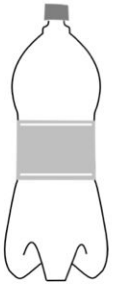

Food & Drink Policy



Students may bring a light, healthy, snack and refillable water. Snacks are not for sharing. The student will be expected to clean up after themselves.

Absentee Policy

It is the student's responsibility to check with the teacher to make up any assignments missed due to absences.

A student is given 1 extra day to make-up work per day missed.

If bellwork or station work was missed, it is to be completed as homework.

Plagiarism Policy

Plagiarism is taking of ideas or writing of another and presenting them as your own.



This includes:

1. Turning in another's work as your own.
2. Copying work from a friend prior to class.
3. Including a source, but failing to cite it.
4. Copying an author's exact words and passing them off as your own.

Students caught plagiarizing will be given a ZERO for the assignment and NOT be able to redo the assignment.

Late/Incomplete Work



The expectation is that **all assignments** be complete to a level of proficiency (70% or higher) and turned in on time. The teacher may ask students who do not complete work to proficiency to redo the assignment.

Late work will lose 5 points for everyday it is late. Late work will only be accepted for 5 days after the due date. **After the 5th day**, no late work will be accepted. This is to create responsibility and fairness in the classroom.

Electronic Devices

Phones should never be out, unless the teacher has approved the use. Phones should remain turned off and in the student's backpack or given to the teacher to keep until the end of the day. If the student is caught with their phone, it will be sent to the office for parent retrieval.
