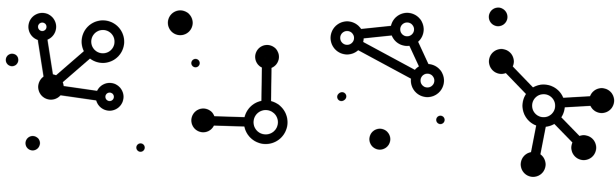

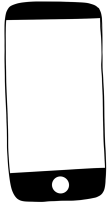
CLASS WORK

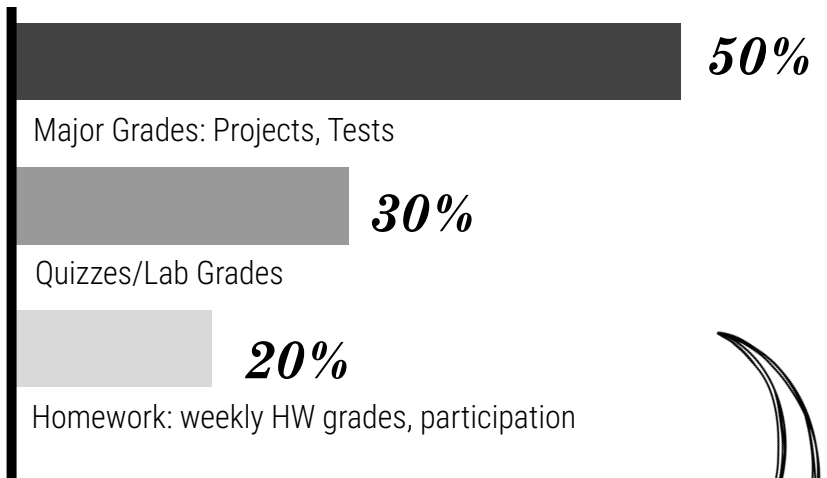
Cheating POLICY :
