

BRAZOS ISD SAFETY AND SECURITY MEETING MINUTES
May 24, 2022

1. Establish a quorum – Call to Order: The Brazos ISD Safety and Security Team held a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, May 24, 2022 in the Brazos ISD Central Administration Office Board Room.

Superintendent, Scott Rogers, began the meeting at 11:49 AM.

2. Introductions: Superintendent, Scott Rogers, verified that formal introductions were not needed as everyone was well acquainted.

3. Approval of November 10, 2021 meeting minutes: Clay Hudgins moved with a second by Myles Marek to approve the minutes of the November 10, 2021 meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

4.1 Discussion of Security Audit and Emergency

Operations Plan: Superintendent, Scott Rogers, reviewed old business with the committee, including framework of the Emergency Operations Plan, FEMA training, an explanation of the Raptor response system, a verbal MOU with Guarding Angel Church to use their facility in the event of an emergency where students need to be evacuated, and National Incident Management System (NIMS) training; the committee will take active shooter training. New business included keyless entry at the campuses, alarm system vs the swipe system was discussed.

Updates/edits/changes to the Basic Plan were discussed. Numbering doors at campuses will be completed this summer. District audit will be in Spring 2023. Training opportunities for different subjects were discussed.
