Course Description: US History will be an in-depth study of the history of the United States since Reconstruction.

Student Expectations:

Students are expected to make a commitment to manage their time wisely, read, study, take notes, ask questions, think on their own, be organized, read outside material, problem solve, and be an active and positive contributor to each class period.

Technology in the Classroom: Per district policy, all personal electronic devices will be turned off during the day unless, including during all testing. If used without authorization, the first offense is confiscation and a \$15 fine for the parent to pick up at the end of the day from the principal's office, or can, wait three days and pick up without the \$15 fee.
