Child Nutrition
Charge Policy
2022-2023 School Year

Students at all campus levels will be allowed to charge up to three days' worth of meals (3 breakfast and 3 lunches.) The child nutrition department will also notify parents with a notice stating their child has a negative balance, negative dollar amount will reflect in this notification. Notices will be sent home with the student or mailed to address on file. Once the student has charged the maximum allowed amount, the student will be provided an alternate meal until charges are paid. Parents/Guardians can make payments online through the districts website via Lunch Money Now, send check or cash to your child's campus. Brazos ISD encourages all families who may qualify for free/reduced benefits to fill out the free/reduced lunch application, which are available at all campuses. If a student has a negative amount on their account, they will not be allowed to purchase extras or ala carte items until the meal charges are paid in full.
