Brazos ISD recognizes the legislative intent of HB 2 and is committed to reducing the hiring of uncertified teachers beginning with the 2025-2026 school year and being in full compliance by the 2029-2030 school year.

Educator Preparation Program Partnerships

Brazos ISD maintains and is formalizing Memoranda of Understandings(MOU) with the following Educator Preparation Programs to fully certify our teachers:

- iTeach Texas
- Teachworthy
- Texas Teachers of Tomorrow

All fully certified teachers are required to:

- Enroll in an approved EPP with 30 days of hiring
- Demonstrate continuous progress toward standard certification.

Certified teachers seeking additional certifications are supported through alternative method such as: targeted exam preparation, testing support, and district monitored timelines.

Transition to Full Certification Compliance:

Brazos ISD's transition plan provides a structured, year-over-year reduction of uncertified teachers assigned to foundation curriculum courses while ensuring instructional continuity and student support.
