In 2025 the Austin County Retired Teachers' Association will offer scholarships to public high school students who will be pursuing a career in teaching. It is the goal of ACRTA to present scholarships in a minimum of \$500 to students attending Bellville High School, Brazos High School, and Sealy High School.

Students must be college ready when they apply to a college or university. Scholarships will be based on their academics, activities, community involvement, and the desire to work with students in a public school.

The application form may be completed by hand or online. A high school transcript with grades, state testing scores, evidence of SAT or ACT scores, current picture, and three letters of recommendation must accompany the application. All items are to be mailed to the Scholarship Chairman of the Austin County Retired Teachers Association and postmarked by <u>April 5, 2025</u>. Applicants should contact the people who will write the letters of recommendation early so the letters can be completed in time to be included with the application packet; if preferred, the letters may be emailed to regolan@att.net.

Recipients of the scholarships will be notified by telephone and by mail. They will also be awarded a certificate of their scholarship at their school's spring awards program. Before scholarship funds will be sent, each recipient must verify that he/she is enrolled as a full time student taking at least 12 hours in a college and must present an identification number to the ACRTA.
