

Are you a high school senior with an agricultural background and looking to pursue a career within the agricultural industry? Capital Farm Credit awards \$1,000 scholarships to graduating seniors across its market territories. Youth scholarships are awarded using the following eligibility requirements:

- Funds shall be used to attend an accredited vocational or technical school, college or university. Student must maintain full-time status.
- Applicants must be high school seniors, graduating within the current school year.
- Applicants must demonstrate that they have a tentative educational plan and goals, related to fields
 in agriculture or natural resources (may include Ag Communications, Ag Economics, Ag Business, Ag
 Education, Wildlife or Ranch Management, etc.)

 Applicants must include the completed application, recent high school transcript and two letters of recommendation.
