

## **Brazos Band Boosters Club Scholarship Requirements**

### Achievement:

The Brazos Band Boosters Club will consider scholarships for all seniors meeting the established criteria. The amount awarded will be based on funds raised for scholarship purposes and will be distributed evenly among all those applicants who qualify, with the maximum available per student being \$500.

### Criteria – The Applicant must:

1. Be a senior at Brazos High School and enrolled in the band.
2. Be a minimum three year participant (Sophomore, Junior, and Senior) in BHS Band Department and recommended by the Director of Bands, with the possible exception for new students on a case by case basis.
3. Have plans to obtain college or vocational degree and continue to pursue music and/or color guard beyond the high school level.
4. Have maintained an 80-100 plus GPA average during senior year.
5. Complete an essay and answer questions specified on the scholarship application form attached.

### Summary:

The above guidelines were established to cover the annual scholarships to be presented by the Brazos Band Boosters Club. All criteria and deadlines will be strictly adhered to in order to provide a consistent evaluation process.

**The Deadline for the completed application is May 1st.** All completed applications must be turned into the Brazos Director of Bands. No applications will be accepted after this date.

All scholarship winners will be responsible for showing proof of enrollment or a cancelled check made out to a college or vocational school no later than one year from the date of graduation to receive the award.
