

A native of Eagle Lake, Stanley enlisted in the U.S. Navy at age 17 wanting to serve his country. After his tour of service, Stanley returned home and enrolled in Texas A&M where he earned his degree in Civil Engineering. In 1950, he began his career with the Fort Bend County drainage district eventually becoming County Engineer – working diligently for 37 years until retirement. Stanley dedicated his life to providing the best possible service to his country, his county, and especially his community. The towering list of Stanley's accolades include:
