## SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

The following is a list of qualifications that are to be met when selecting a recipient for the Catholic Daughter Scholarship, as approved and adopted by Court Queen of Angels # 1538, on November 10, 2003 and revised on January 25, 2017, and then on February 8, 2021.

- 1. Must be a child of a Catholic Daughters of America member of Court Queen of Angels #1538 who is in good standing for at least two full years.
- 2. If there is no eligible CDA member's child, then scholarship will go to eligible grandchild of CDA member of Court Queen of Angels # 1538 who is in good standing for at least two full years.
- 3. If there is no eligible CDA member's child or grandchild, then the scholarship will go to eligible great grandchild of CDA member of Court Queen of Angels # 1538 who is in good standing for at least two full years.
- 4. Must be an active member of the Catholic Church or Christian based church and involved in church activities.
- 5. Recipient must be going to college or other school of higher education.
- 6. Scholarship will be paid to college/school or recipient upon receipt of "proof of registration".
- 7. Committee shall select an alternate, if needed, in case of default.
- 8. Recipient should be in the top 25% of their class or have a cumulative grade pt. average of 3.0.
- 9. Recipient is to be selected by the scholarship committee and regent.
- 10. Committee will utilize "official transcript" information requested by the applicant from the school counselor. "Official transcript" must be sent to CDA Ct. Queen of Angels #1538, P.O. Box 705, Wallis, TX, 77485, by the counselor and postmarked by deadline date stated on the application. If submitted with application, must be original and in a sealed envelope from the school counselor. Counselors are familiar with requests.
- 11. Mother or grandmother of student eligible for the scholarship cannot serve on the Court Scholarship Committee for the current year.
- 12. Each scholarship award will be \$750. A minimum of one scholarship can be awarded by the court each year there is a qualified applicant and the court may award additional scholarships if funds are available.
- 13. There will be one essay question on the scholarship. "In your daily life, how do you express yourself as a Christian? How do you treat others: family, friends, people that you do not know? How do you model your Christian beliefs?"
- 14. Candidate must fill out Court Queen of Angels # 1538 current year application to be considered for the scholarship and an "official transcript" received. See #10 above.
