 - Must include signed application certification statement.
- > Copy of official high school transcript and/or college transcript (must include fall semester grades and have stamp and/or seal).
- > Proof of acceptance to university, college, or technical school for Fall 2024 or current enrollement.
- ➤ Reference letters from a teacher, employer, coach, minister, or other adult community member. No family members will be allowed.
 - Minimum of 1 letter and a maximum of 3 letters will be accepted.
