Late work will not be given a grade higher than a 50. You will have 1 day for each day absent to complete any missed assignment(s). After that it will be considered late.

Pop Quizzes:

Be prepared! I will randomly give pop quizzes throughout the six weeks. Hint: keep up with the reading assignments and homework.
